## Uptown-downtown shuttle service starts



A special new "uptown to downtown" shuttle bus service aimed at bar hoppers, theatergoers and concert lovers will kick off this weekend in Metro Detroit.

Night Move LLC is intended to move passengers from hip, happening Royal Oak to funky, fabulous Ferndale and then to delightful downtown Detroit via Woodward Avenue and Interstate 75. Since it's just starting, the shuttle bus service is initially limited to 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. Fridays and Saturdays, but service could expand to other nights and routes if business is good.

Here's how it works: passengers sign up online for tickets (\$12) entitling them to ride the shuttle with hourly pickups/drop offs at three locations: 208 Fifth St. (near the Fifth Street bar), in Royal Oak; at the corner of Troy and Woodward (near the Woodward Avenue Brewery) in Ferndale; and at Beaubien and Monroe in Greektown.

The ticket guarantees riders a spot on the 30-passenger bus for specific pickup and drop-off times. (If there's enough room passengers will be allowed to ride the bus as many times as they want on that particular evening.) If ticket holders wish to stay longer at a particular location than they booked, they can ride the next bus back if there's room.
